Is Online Education the Right Decision Me?

Online learning offers great flexibility for students and can be a solution to some traditional school problems. To help determine if online learning is right for you, consider the following questions.

Are you self-motivated?

- ✓ **Most of the learning happens on your schedule, so you will be responsible for creating the structure needed to finish each course.**
- ✓ **You will need to be self-directed and motivated to complete activities and initiate the communication required with your online and mentor teachers.**

Do you have good time management?

- ✓ **You are responsible for managing your time in order to maintain the pace necessary to achieve your minimum progress and graduation goal.**

Do you have strong reading and writing skills?

- ✓ **Reading content is the primary method of communication in the online classes and writing is the one of the main ways you show your online teacher what you've learned.**

Will you ask questions when you need to?

- ✓ **It is important to let your instructor or mentor know when you need assistance. You will need to advocate for yourself.**

Do I have the time to devote to online classes?

- ✓ **Even though you can work at your own pace, to be sure you reach your graduation goal you will have to be able to devote the necessary study time.**

Are your computer, internet, and technical skills adequate?

- ✓ **To be successful in the online classroom, you need to be comfortable with internet searches, emailing with attachments, word processing, downloading and uploading files**
