Dear Parents,

I am excited to inform you of an alternative educational opportunity that we would like you to consider for your current high school student. The Woodhaven-Brownstown School District offers an online educational experience with blended opportunities at “Maple Grove Alternative High School”.

There are many differences between WHS and MGAHS. The two most significant differences will be the manner in which credits are earned from the two schools as well as the number of credits that are required to earn a diploma from each school. In order to earn a diploma from Maple Grove Alternative High School, students will need to earn the 18 credits the state of Michigan requires in their Michigan Merit Curriculum. Students enrolled in the MGAHS will do the great majority of their work from home through an online learning experience by taking classes through the GenNet online learning program. Students will report to school to take their exams, to meet with their monitor teacher who monitors student progress, or to receive one-on-one tutoring.

Please know that online learning is not for everyone. Your child will need to work many hours each week in order to be successful and pass their online classes. If you are interested in exploring this option for your child please fill out the attached paperwork and contact Mr. Phil Short at Woodhaven High School, by calling (734-789-2066), in order to make an appointment.

By choosing to enroll in this Alternative High School please know that your child will be removing themselves as a Woodhaven High School student which means they will not be able to participate in WHS activities like athletics, clubs, dances, etc. Transportation is not provided to MGAHS. When your child completes their 18 required credits they will receive a diploma from Maple Grove Alternative High School and not Woodhaven High School.
